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Meet **Stephanie Maze**, Executive Editor of **Healthy Foods from A to Z / Comida sana de la A a la Z**

Stephanie Maze, Project Editor of the award-winning **MOMENTS IN THE WILD** series in English & Spanish, also produced the acclaimed **I WANT TO BE...** series about careers published by Harcourt Brace Children's Books. In 1998, this series earned a place on VOYA's Nonfiction Honor list, and two of the titles, **I Want To Be A Veterinarian** and **I Want To Be An Engineer** were named "Outstanding Science Trade Books" by the National Science Teachers Association and the Children's Book Council. A third title, **I Want To Be A Chef**, received a starred review in *School Library Journal* in 1999.

A photographer for over 30 years (as well as a certified teacher), Ms. Maze's work has won a number of awards in both the prestigious National Press Photographers and White House Press Photographers Associations, and has appeared in exhibits and publications worldwide, including among others, *National Geographic*—where she was a regular freelance photographer for more than ten years, the *San Francisco Chronicle* (as a staff photographer for six years), *German GEO*, *Time*, *Newsweek*, *People*, *The Smithsonian Magazine*, *The Washington Post*, and *The New York Times*. Ms. Maze was also a photographer on ten **Day in the Life** book projects and three Summer Olympic Games for the IOPP and Associated Press. Ms. Maze has lived all over the world, speaks five languages fluently and resides in Sarasota, Florida.

Born in Baltimore, Maryland, advertising photographer **Renée Comet** went to college to become a nurse but fell in love with photography and transferred to the Rochester Institute of Technology to pursue a degree in photo illustration. Hired by Time-Life to photograph a cookbook series, she moved to Washington, D.C., where her company, Renée Comet Photography, Inc., is located today.

Specializing in food and still photography, Ms. Comet has photographed nearly 40 books on food in the past 25 years, including **The Artful Pie**, **The Artful Vegan**, **Mrs. Fields Cookie Book**, **The Mount Vernon Cookbook**, **Dining at Monticello**, **Delicious by Design**, and **CakeLove: How to Bake Cakes from Scratch**. Her client list includes *National Geographic*, the Smithsonian Institution, Wal-Mart, Whole Foods, The National Cancer Institute, The Ritz Carlton, USDA, Marriott International, the American Diabetes Association, and many others. She also contributes regularly to *The Washington Post*, the *Vegetarian Times*, and *Washingtonian* magazine, and her photographs have also been featured on five U.S. stamps, including Wedding Cake and Wedding Rings of 2009 and Wedding Roses of 2011.

Whatever the subject, Ms. Comet's visual treatment can be best described as uncomplicated, fluid, and elegant.
